Inter-Municipal Planning Strategy and First Truro Shopping Centres Ltd.

1. Refers the UARB decision regarding the proposed First Truro Shopping Centres development project to JPAC and staff for development of possible IMPS Amendments
2. Authorizes staff to carry out a public participation session in accordance with the Policy on Inter-Municipal Planning Projects, regarding possible IMPS amendments
3. Sets August 31, 2000 as the date for first reading of possible IMPS Amendments by Council
4. Authorizes staff in consultation with Town staff to set September 25, 2000, or such other date as may be agreed by joint staff, as a date for a Joint Public Hearing and second reading of possible IMPS Amendments by the Councils and to do any necessary advertising therefore

5. Refers the proposed First Truro Shopping Centres Development Agreement to JPAC and staff for review pursuant to the possible amended IMPS
6. Authorized staff in consultation with Town staff to set October 16, 2000, or such other date as may be agreed by joint staff, as a date for a Public Hearing on the Proposed First Truro Shopping Centres Development agreement and to do any necessary advertising therefore.” Motion Carried.
